

Proper labelling and packaging



Labelling and packaging


General guidelines:

- Remove any old labelling (eg. numbers and danger labels) from the packaging to avoid any misunderstandings
- Take care that the packaging is clean and dry to ensure that the labels stick to the packaging
- Small units should be gathered on pallets, wrapped by shrink film and labelled on the outside
- When possible danger labels should be placed on the same side as the UN number


Declaration label

Contains declaration number, packaging type and number, waste description and UN number.




Hazardous waste

Should be provided with a declaration and a label with declaration number.




Dangerous goods

Should be delivered in UN approved packaging and provided with a declaration, label with declaration number and UN number as well as danger label.



Positioning of labels and danger labels



Tight head drums and open top drums

The packaging should be labelled only on top.
Always insert the locking pin in the hose clip.




Cans

The packaging should be labelled only on top.




Buckets and other small packaging

The label should be placed on top.




IBCs

The packaging should be labelled on two opposite sides and on top. We will send you three labels. The packaging number is the same on all labels.




Bigbags


The packaging is labelled on the strap at the top.



Containers

The packaging should be labelled on two opposite sides and on top. We will send you three labels. The packaging number is the same on all labels.






fluorescent tubes

The packaging should be labelled only on top.

Correct packing and positioning on pallets



- The packaging must fit the waste, be tight and closed in a proper manner.
- All residues of waste on the outside of the packaging and old labels must be removed.
- The weight limits of the packaging type must be complied with.
- The pallets must match the weight and size of the packaging.
- Always use stable and undamaged pallets which are not short of straws.
- The packaging must be secured to avoid moving during transport.

Worth knowing

- When you order declaration labels from our Customer Service Team or if you print via eDBS you will automatically get the correct amount of labels for your packaging.
- Some types of packaging are provided with a label showing where to place the label.
